I am a film Writer, Director, and Editor and have directed and edited commercials, music videos and television.

HOLIDAY (Feriado), my debut feature, premiered at the 64th Berlinale in 2014, after receiving the Tribeca Film Institute's narrative Voces Award in 2012. To date, HOLIDAY has been screened at over 70 film festivals and has distribution in 22 countries.

BLACK HOLE (Agujero negro), my second feature, premiered in the BAFICI film festival in Buenos Aires in 2018 and was Ecuador's official selection to the Spanish Goya Awards. In 2018, the film received the Audience Award at FLAC-Q, the Latin American Film Festival in Quito and the Jury Award at the Ecuadorian Film Festival in New York. That same year, I received the Quito Municipal Award Agustín Cuesta Ordóñez for the Best Film of the year.

I am currently developing my third feature, FANGO (MUD), a horror film that will be produced by New York-based Zero Chill, producers of Netflix' Vampires Vs. The Bronx.

In addition to this, I teach Film Directing, Editing, and Screenwriting at Universidad San Francisco de Quito. In August 2020, I founded Zine.ec, a streaming platform for Ecuadorian and Latin American film.
